

#### 2023-24 Budget

Budget planning is well underway for 2023-24. To help inform trustees in setting priorities for the efficient, effective, and equitable use of board resources, a public consultation survey was conducted between February 8 and March 8. Thank you to all our stakeholders who took time to participate and share feedback. Emerging themes from the survey and the process for the 2023-24 budget will be shared at upcoming Business Committee of the Whole meetings.



#### **Community Planning and Partnerships**

Our board's annual Community Planning and Partnerships meeting will be held virtually on Tuesday, April 25, 2023 as partners from local upper and lower tier municipalities and other organizations join us to share planning information. This meeting has served as a venue to spark further discussions on potential opportunities to share unused space in our schools. The public is welcome to join to observe.



#### **Policy Update**

Since our new term of office began in November, the Policy Standing Committee has met regularly, recommending several policies to the board for approval.

## **Building for the Future**

Work continues on a number of build projects in BWDSB, including two new replacement schools:

- junior kindergarten to Grade 8 <u>Beavercrest Community School replacement</u> in Markdale
- Grade 7 to 12 replacement for Kincardine District Senior School

Ministry of Education funding has also been received for expanded child care at the following schools:

- new stand alone facility with two-room child care centre and two-room EarlyON Child and Family Centre, <u>Egremont Community School</u>, Holstein

Hosted by the Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program at the Owen Sound campus of Georgian College, six BWDSB students secured a chance to compete at the Skills Ontario Qualifying Competitions in Barrie to be held in April.
